



Special Requirements

If you have special requirements, you should mention this in your application and give a brief description in the space provided.

You must also provide medical/professional evidence to support any requests you may have. Depending on the circumstances, your request may have to be forwarded to the Cambridge Special Circumstances Unit who will decide whether to grant your request or not. Your medical/professional evidence should be no more than two years old.

Please note that it can take up to three months to receive modified test materials for an IELTS test.

If you have dyslexia, you may be granted 15 minutes extra for the reading and writing papers as well as a separate room with max 5 candidates on the submission of your medical/professional evidence. If you wish to have more than 15 minutes extra time or would like to use a computer, your application must be sent to the Cambridge Special Circumstances Unit. **The use of spell check is not allowed regardless of whether you are allowed to use a computer or not.**
