Do you have an academic education in a medical profession from another country? Do you want to combine intensive Swedish studies with a vocational orientation and rapidly get ready for employment?

We have an education for you! Sfi Trelleborg offers intensive studies in Swedish for immigrants, Sfi, in the center of Trelleborg. Principal and responsible for Sfi Trelleborg is Folkhögskolan Hvilan in collaboration with Folkuniversitetet.

SFIMP is for you who have

- a foreign medical education (eg. physician, dentist, physiotherapist, pharmacist)
- the time and motivation to study 25 class hours a week

SFIMP offers

- Sfi 3, course C and D – intensive studies at a fast pace
- Start on the study level that fits you the best – individual plan
- Guidance, incl. support in the handling of diplomas, application to Socialstyrelsen
- Professional portfolio
- Vocational education, incl. socio-linguistic aspects, medical vocabulary, workshops, authentic texts and exercises for vocational Swedish · Project-oriented way of working with focus on the medical field, external lecturers and study visits
- Internship, if necessary
- Labor market and organizations
- Network with people from all over the world with the same educational and professional background
