



Special Arrangements

If you have special requirements, and you wish to do the IELTS-on-Paper test, you should select "I have accessibility needs for the test date". You must also provide medical evidence to support any requests you may have. Depending on the circumstances, your request may have to be forwarded to the Cambridge Special Circumstances Unit who will decide whether to grant your request or not. Please note that it can take up to three months to receive modified test materials for an IELTS test.

If you wish to do the IELTS-on-Computer test, it is possible to be granted extra time if, for example, you have dyslexia. Again, medical evidence must be provided. Please email us at the same time as you register for your test including your medical report to discuss what may be possible.

If you have dyslexia, the general allocation of extra time is 15 minutes for the reading and writing papers, as well as a separate room with a maximum of 5 candidates on the submission of your medical evidence. Your test will be marked according to the usual criteria.

N.B. Candidates with special requirements may not be able to do the test on their preferred test date due to possible administrative and/or logistical reasons but we will do our utmost to ensure you can take the test either on or near your preferred test date.
