

NEWSLETTER 2 - CURRENT STATE OF THE PROJECT - FALL 2023

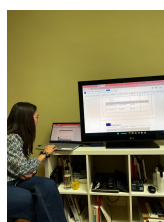
Over the last few months, the project team has finalized the Peer4Inclusion Handbook, held a transnational partner meeting in Bilbao, and have started the first part of the training course – including finalizing the success stories from inspiring migrants!

Handbook for migrants and refugees

The project team has written and finalized the Peer4Inclusion handbook – this document provides valuable resources for organizations and training centers aiming to train Peer Mentors for newly arrived migrants. It offers innovative learning materials that can enhance training programs and customize learning paths. The handbook will shortly be published on Peer4Inclusion website.

First Transnational Project Meeting

During April the team met in Bilbao, Spain. During the meeting the handbook was discussed, as the validation of the handbook and the next steps of the project, including success stories, called “living the real life” as the first part of the Peer4Inclusion training course. It was decided that the success stories will be videos.



Next steps

The project team is now moving forward with producing the rest of the training course, which is designed to train future Peer4Inclusion Mentors. It includes modules that help mentors understand key concepts, improve essential skills, and become familiar with tools for mentoring migrant people and refugees.
