THE PROJECT'S AIM

WIFI is an Erasmus+ project that was developed with the aim of responding to the needs of illiterate or functional illiterate adults. The project's main goal is to help the target group have access to a first job or training, through the organization of thematic workshops. The aim is to provide them with a first professional experience accessible to their level and allowing them to work on their initial skills through experience and to develop them in order to access vocational training.

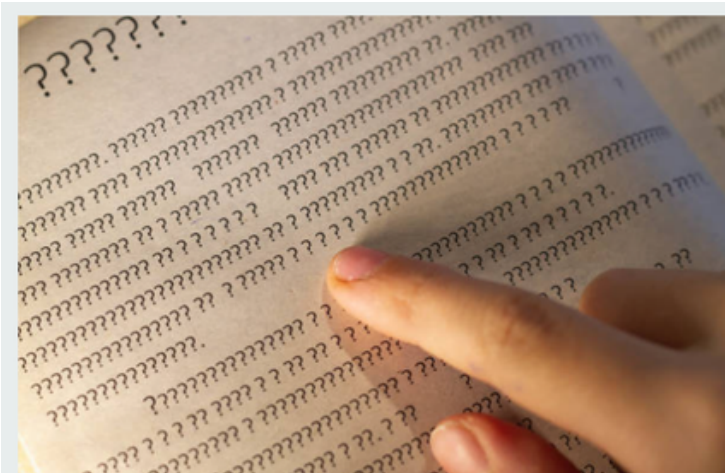

More precisely, the project aims to:

- Strengthen training systems to meet the challenges presented by illiteracy.
- Put the target group (adult illiterates) in a working environment within the framework of their training/ learning.
- Enhance their ability to learn in non-academic learning settings.

Professionally develop VET teachers, trainers and mentors in training creation: There is a need to equip the trainers in a way that makes them able to respond to the needs of the trainees.



DURATION AND PARTNERSHIP

The project started in November 2021 and is supposed to end in October 2023.

It gathers 5 partners from Europe, representing the following organisations:



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All those partner organizations were gathered in order to combine and complement their expertise in the field of education and training as well as labor market and social inclusion. This partnership utilizes its expertise in a way to ensure a more efficient impact on the project's target group.

INTELLECTUAL OUTPUTS

The project is constructed of the following four intellectual outputs:

1. A study circle (peer learning and conception experience) that will lead to the creation of the skill map toolset and explanatory interview guidance.
2. A skills map taking the form of precise indicators and descriptors to evaluate the trainees.
3. WIFI workshop. It will contain the creation of several in-situ workshop exercises taking into account the 8 EU basic key skills.
4. Workshop pilot. At this last stage of the project, partners will be piloting and experimenting the skills map, tool set, exercises and workshops designed in output 2 & 3 among the target group.

This will lead to the development of a model based on 4 workshops containing precise curricular activities and exercises targeting illiteracy.



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CURRENT STAGE OF THE PROJECT

The project's kick-off meeting was held in Vélez-Málaga, Spain during the 13th and 14th of December 2021. The meeting gave the opportunity for partners to get to meet each other in person, to interact and discuss the main milestones of the project. Partners also had the chance of precisely discussing and agreeing on the detailed activities and deadlines of the first intellectual outcome.

In the aftermath of the kick-off meeting, partners have successfully finalized the first intellectual output which consisted of conducting study circles in each partner country.

The second transnational meeting was recently held on the 5th and 6th of May 2022 in Uppsala, Sweden where partners had the chance of following up on the main cross-cutting topics of the project and discussing the second intellectual output with the expected deadlines.
